CLASS 1: Safety Assessment Program - Evaluator Training

This class will train civil, structural, geotechnical engineers, architects, and building inspectors to do field evaluations of buildings and other infrastructure for safety.

CLASS 2: Safety Assessment Program - Coordinator Training

This class will train local government representatives on how to estimate the local needs for the Evaluators, how to request them, and how to manage them and the information they gather.
